### Summer Internship Information:

NAPAWF is now accepting applications for full-time student interns for the summer of 2019. We are seeking applicants with independent funding through their universities or other fellowship or internship programs, and we will work with them to provide all supporting documentation necessary to obtain such funding. Interns will work in our Washington, D.C., office under the direct supervision of NAPAWF's Policy Manager.

The summer policy intern will support the work of NAPAWF's Policy team. The intern will:

- Develop research products and deliverables such as fact sheets, issue briefs, and reports exploring specific issues at the intersection of reproductive health and rights, immigrant rights, and economic justice issues facing AAPI women and girls
- Assist in tracking NAPAWF's relevant policy issues on the federal and state levels
- Support the Policy team in advocacy efforts on the Hill in order to advance NAPAWF's policy goals and relationships
- Assist in developing communications materials on timely policy issues
- Participate in coalition meetings on behalf of NAPAWF

### Qualifications Requested:

- Currently enrolled in undergraduate institution, master's degree candidates welcome;
- Strong policy research and writing skills
- Ability to work well both independently and in a team to keep projects moving forward
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Enthusiasm for social justice issues
- Prior experience working on issues involving reproductive rights and health, , immigrant rights, AAPI issues, women's issues, or economic justice preferred
- Fluency in an Asian language is a plus
